Higher Education for the 21st Century: Innovations in University-Society Partnerships

The third Critical Edge Alliance conference will be held at the Tata Institute of Social Sciences in Mumbai, India, **September 21st to 23rd, 2017**. The purpose of the conference is to bring together scholars, students, and administrators, who are interested in innovative and experimental approaches to higher education and wish to share their ideas and experiences with colleagues from around the world. We are not only interested in papers that contribute to research on higher education, but also in examples of best practices. This year the conference will focus upon University - Society Partnerships and we therefore especially encourage posters, papers, and panels on:

1. Democratizing Higher Education: Making Learning Available and Accessible to All
2. Co-Creativities: University - Society Partnerships
3. Co-Learnings: Innovative and Critical Pedagogies

Proposals for posters, papers and panels should be submitted to ceatissabstracts2017@tiss.edu no later than June 29th, 2017. Abstracts for posters and papers (25 minutes, including discussion) should be no more than 800 words. Panels (1.5 hours, including discussion) can consist of 3-4 papers.

Registration for the conference will be possible starting in July 2017. The conference fee is kept as low as possible (200-300\$, depending upon time of registration and institutional affiliation) and covers food and refreshments during the conference. The final deadline for registration is September 8th, 2017.

Students are encouraged to participate in a student workshop, which will be held before the conference, September 19th to 20th, 2017.
